

PROVING YOUR RIGHT TO WORK IN THE UK:

Any one of the documents in this table will be acceptable proof of your right to work in the UK. An employer does not require any further proof.

A passport showing that the holder is a British citizen, or has a right of abode in the United Kingdom.
A document showing that the holder is a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland. This must be a national passport or national identity card. See the introduction to this handbook for a list of EEA countries.
A residence permit issued by the Home Office to a national from a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.
A passport or other document issued by the Home Office which has an endorsement stating that the holder has a current right of residence in the United Kingdom as the family member of a national from a European Economic Area country or Switzerland who is resident in the United Kingdom.
A passport or other travel document endorsed to show that the holder can stay indefinitely in the United Kingdom, or has no time limit on their stay.
A passport or other travel document endorsed to show that the holder can stay in the United Kingdom; and that this endorsement allows the holder to do the type of work the employer is offering even if they do not have a work permit.
An Application Registration Card issued by the Home Office to an asylum seeker stating that the holder is permitted to take employment.

Or you can prove your right by provide two documents from this table, including one from each column.
