WHAT YOU CAN DO IF YOU DON'T SPEAK GOOD ENGLISH AND NEED TO GO INTO A SCHOOL:

If you speak little or no English, you may need an interpreter when you visit the school. The school should be able to help you find one. If you want to talk to the school about your child, it can be awkward if your child is acting as your interpreter. Your child's school may have a teacher with special responsibility who you can talk to about problems or worries. It is important, for example, that your child receives the necessary support to ensure they can do the same lessons as the others in their class. Some schools have teachers specialising in English for foreigners will work with class teachers.
