

Paul will give a fixed quote for any job. He's very quick so this makes sense for clients. Ordinarily he works from a home-office but will work onsite anywhere (and has done overseas). In a typical day he'd expect to generate up to 2,000 words of fresh copy or edit as many as 10,000 words. He charges nothing in respect of sundry expenses, and nor does he charge extra for unsocial hours. He'll often take on work overnight or during the weekends, so he's a great emergency stop-gap!

But, for those who want to employ him by the clock instead of simply to complete a job, typical charges (which are invariably pre-agreed) are as follows:

| By the hour | $£ 50$ * |
| :--- | :--- |
| By the day (8 hours) | $£ 400$ * |
| By the week | $£ 1,750$ * (i.e. $£ 350$ per 8-hour day) |

* Plus any travel costs including subsistence where appropriate and including travel time as being part of the working day - if necessary and pre-agreed.
